FORESTRY PRINCE broke alert wresting a short lead then holding that edge through the turn, swerved out at the head of the lane quickly correcting course while holding KYLE'S TREASURY at bay the final eighth. KYLE'S TREASURY raced evenly rallying from the turn taking aim abreast FORESTRY PRINCE in upper stretch, kept rival honest applying constant pressure from the eighth pole. MUSIC FROM HEAVEN slow early gave a mild rally to contention into upper stretch, gave even action from the four path in drive. PEPPERBERRY slow early angled to the inside gaining position from the rail. STORM DAMAGE outrun early gave a modest move to upper stretch failing to menace in drive. COUNT THE DREAMS stumbled from the gate played no factor after. HIBACHI sent hard chased under the whip through the turn, wilted into upper stretch. QUESTIONABLE SKY chased the pace through the turn then gave way into upper stretch. POWER HITTER squeezed hard was forced to check at the break, rushed after had little chance. TRICK MAN showed early speed, gave way sharply from the three sixteenths pole.
