CHEROKEE WARPAINT well placed stalking the leader racing between foes down the backside, sat patient to mid turn, collared SUNSHINE BO leaving the quarter pole and dueled to upper stretch, drew clear inside the eighth pole under aggressive urging. UNLEADED raced in good tracking position along the rail to the half, moved up mid turn taking aim on duelers at the quarter pole, angled out four wide top of the lane, chased throughout the stretch run proving a willing second best. SUNSHINE BO set a solid tempo traveling a little off the rail, headed past the quarter pole by the winner, battled to mid stretch, weakened and was fully extended to hold on to third place at the finish. HARPERS LAND unhurried and trailed to midway on the bend, gained along the rail from upper stretch, finished with interest. ROBYN IT raced evenly at mid track, failed to threaten. KONA KID flashed brief foot, began to fade leaving the far turn, no factor. BLUE KNIGHT stalked traveling three wide to the half, gave way entering the stretch finishing spent.
