Footnotes

OPTIMISTIC BULLET (BRZ) stalked PEGGY'S LEGACY down the backside, bid for the lead at the quarter pole, took over entering the stretch, traveled in the four path throughout the stretch drive, held safe under steady pressure. LUBAVA tracked the pace racing towards the inside, rallied mid stretch, loomed off the winner a sixteenth out, missed while saving second place in a good effort. SUPERTUNIA stalked early on, swung out five wide upper stretch, was outgamed late and settled for third place. MADDYABOUTYOU raced evenly in the second flight, put to left handed stick in upper stretch, closed in on top trio coming to the wire running between rivals at the finish. BURL'S JUNIANA unhurried early racing mid track, was hard ridden from top of the stretch, lacked needed surge. JESSIE'S KNOCKOUT lacked speed running at mid track, never threatened. QUEEN OF FORTUNE was always outrun, never involved. PEGGY'S LEGACY sent early, angled towards the rail while clearing, headed at the quarter pole, stopped in upper stretch finishing used up.
