TINKER stalked close up through the turn, wrested the lead in the four path upper stretch edging clear under a drive. SUNDAY MISSILE tracked the pace going evenly through the turn, bid four wide in upper stretch extending up for place. HACHI a step slow through the turn angled five wide in upper stretch responding late to finish well. HARD TWO IMAGINE slow early was outrun through the turn, mustered a mild rally in mid stretch improving near mid track. A BREW IN TH WOODS brushed at the break raced evenly off the pace throughout. MOUNTAIN A. P. veered in brushing at the break, rushed along pursued through the turn then wore out in upper stretch. RED DWARF sent clear set the pace through the turn, hooked in upper stretch gave way on the inside. CRAP SHOOT played no factor. WANNA BE AN ANGEL raced evenly through the turn then folded on the inside in upper stretch. ASHORE was always outrun.
