Footnotes

STORM CLOCK raced up close stalking duelers throughout, asked near the 1/4 pole, came along the inside top of the lane when FREE MOONSHINE angled wide entering the stretch, vied in a four way battle to deep stretch, held a slim lead late and was all out to last for the victory. RINGO'S CAT was rated and raced wide down the backside, swung 8 wide in upper stretch, rallied throughout and finished fastest of all to just miss at the wire, game effort. FREE MOONSHINE sent hard, held a head lead throughout, drifted out to the 4 path top of the lane, vied in the lane while between rivals, was out gamed inside the 1/16 pole, hard try. HONOUR SID hustled from the gate, pressed outside of FREE MOONSHINE on the turn, was carried out top of the lane and vied while between rivals in the lane, was all out and got outfinished in deep stretch, game try. WILD MEETING hustled from the gate, tracked while 4 wide on the turn, was floated out to 6 wide at the 1/8 pole, vied from there but was outfinished late. DOMINATING well placed early, tracked and angled to the rail in upper stretch, lacked rally, evenly. SHADYREST had no speed, asked but lacked rally, never threatened. TELEPSYCHIC was slow early, asked in upper stretch,gave no response, never factored.
