LOUIS THE STRIKER hustled up on the inside, wrested a clear lead on the turn, cut loose to go well clear in upper stretch, put away late winning ridden out. MELISSA'S STAR slow early, varied little through the turn, cut the corner advancing on tired rivals from the rail in upper stretch, ran down CILLA DILLA late to salvage place. CILLA DILLA sent hard to go close up to the turn, pursued LOUIS THE STRIKER emerging from the pack into upper stretch, was clearly no match for winner wearing down late to cede place. PARTY REGENT outrun early, raced evenly posing no menace, gained limited position in drive. QUIET MIST hustled along on the outside, lost ground through the turn, gave way into stretch. PASSION FOR A ROSE broke well with early speed, chased LOUIS THE STRIKER through the turn, folded up at the head of the lane. HALO'S SOLUTION broke sharply to engage LOUIS THE STRIKER on the early pace, pursued rival through the turn, had nothing left at the head of the lane. MISS WEA BABY labored throughout. RHYMESWITHCLASS refused at the break, finally left the gate far behind the field, was breezed around the track.
