BIG THOMPSON stalked RUNFORGLORY from the start racing inside around the turn, angled out to the three path upper stretch, wore down that rival inside the eighth pole, drew clear late under a drive to the finish. RUNFORGLORY broke sharply to set all the pace, held a clear lead at the eighth pole but would be wore down late proving a game second best. LITE MUSIC lacked speed and trailed to the quarter pole, angled four wide upper stretch, finished in willing manner securing the show position late. CATRILLION settled early, rushed a four wide move at the quarter pole, chased top pair turning for home, failed to sustain bid and flattened out late. MR. LATONIA was off a step slow, hustled up to stalk racing three wide around the turn, began to tire mid stretch, no late factor. SNOOPY ROCKS trailed early racing inside, angled at the quarter pole, swung seven wide under a stiff drive top of the lane, failed to respond, no threat. RUNRICORUN raced evenly at mid track, failed to factor. HOT SHOT HANK was hard used from the gate pressing briefly for the lead, stopped leaving the quarter pole, finished being eased across the finish line.
