MARY KATE'S WAY broke sharply grabbing the early lead moving clear on the turn, dug in from the three path down the lane holding firm the final eighth. IMA GIVEN was hustled along emerging off MARY KATE'S WAY on the turn, taking aim from mid track in upper stretch made no headway as a clear second best. FORMALLY ANNOUNCED went evenly through the turn, extended in the two path down the lane held on to position. DEADWOOD DAME in tight at the break varied little on the turn, made mild improvement from the three path the final eighth. TRACK'N DIXIE saved ground traveling evenly throughout. SAYOUNARA SWEETIE was always a step slow finishing up at mid track. DUSK DANCER raced wide playing no factor. NA KELLY dropped back on the turn, raced four wide through the stretch. I'M INUIT laboring throughout was eased to the wire. MARGE GUNDERSON chased through the turn then wilted in upper stretch easing to the wire.
