**Footnotes**

SHIVE'S SUCCESS settled nicely, sat patient to the far turn, quickly gained coming to the quarter pole, vied abreast rivals entering the stretch, drew off from mid stretch and was in hand at the wire. ROAD NOT TRAVELED unhurried racing towards the rear, gained momentum mid turn, rallied four wide top of the lane, finished willingly proving second best. BLUES CROSSING held a good stalking position sitting off a pair of duelers down the backside, gained coming to the quarter pole, dueled running between foes entering the stretch, was no match for the winner and tired late, settled for the show position. THREE MIRACLES was sent early, set a pressured pace for six furlongs, began to weaken in upper stretch, held off others in a good effort. GAME APPEAL lagged far off the pace to the far turn, rallied five wide top of the lane, gave belated surge but was no real threat. EPPING varied little racing in the second flight, never menaced. RED CATUAI stalked along the rail to midway on the second turn, gave way in upper stretch. FIDDLERS PRIDE was hard used in the early going, loomed to the quarter pole, was all done in upper stretch. PATRIOT GAME raced five wide into the first turn, remained well off the rail going down the backstretch, was all done leaving the far turn. WILD PURSUIT raced mid pack running between foes, dropped off top of the stretch and stopped inside the eighth pole finishing well beaten.
