Footnotes

NICKY'S DELIGHT well rated rallied on the far turn working past THE ONE TO CHASE in upper stretch drawing out under a drive. ROAD NOT TRAVELED breaking slowly stayed back to the half, hard ridden through the far turn bid from mid track in upper stretch then angled inside coming on for place. GREAT SHOT well back to the half would swing out seven wide in upper stretch improving with a mild rally. THE ONE TO CHASE sent clear set the pace through the far turn, ceding to NICKY'S DELIGHT in upper stretch would drop off near the rail. STREET SHOES LARRY tracked the pace moving evenly to the half, chased on the far turn then weakened in the three path upper stretch. BOLD COMMAND raced evenly through the backside then dropped off on the far turn laboring home from mid track. HISTORIAN was always outrun. BACKTRACKEN stalked the pace through the backside then flattened out on the far turn. WHITE FLAME stayed close for half a mile then gave way on the far turn.
