Footnotes

TIM HAS MONEY stalked early on racing in hand, made a bold three wide bid for the lead near the quarter pole, took control in upper stretch and widened easily being geared down coming to the wire. AMERICAN INFLUENCE sent hard and angled over to the rail shortly after the start, dueled around the turn, proved no match for TIM HAS MONEY but gamely dug in to save the place position. KYLE'S TREASURY lacked speed racing in the second flight, rallied to split foes in deep stretch, closed strongly just missing second place. DOC'S OPTION raced evenly in mid pack, hard ridden coming five wide top of the lane, leveled off needing more in deep stretch. GENERAL DEPUTY saved ground while tracking the pace, angled out four wide taking aim on the leader turning for home, failed to sustain rally and flattened out late. APOLLONIUS unhurried early, asked leaving the quarter pole, found stride mid stretch, finished with interest but was no real threat. TITANIUMTRENT sent hard, dueled for the lead to the quarter pole, was all done mid stretch giving way. CHEROKEE NATION lacked speed and raced four wide around the bend, varied little never menacing. HONORED PRINCE bumped by CLINT'S CAT at the start, hustled up to race in id pack running towards the inside, weakened leaving the quarter pole. CLINT'S CAT bumped and then bobbed leaving the gate, raced wide down the backside while trailing, never involved.
