PAIGE ME sent hard setting a pressured pace throughout, dug in late running along the rail under an all out drive, just held on being fully extended. AKAPESCHE pressed the winner from the start, traveled three wide around the bend, slowly inched close nearing the wire, just missed in a hard effort. MARYLOVESTETON raced up close from the start, angled a bit in upper stretch to split foes, menaced late in a good try. SUDDSY SUNDAY raced along the rail stalking the duelers, loomed mid stretch under a stiff drive, was outfinished late besting rest. RED BANDIT was slightly bumped shortly after the start, settled towards the rear, rallied four wide from upper stretch, finished willingly. ROCK THE HARBOR stalked around the turn running four wide, loomed off of top pair at the quarter pole, needed more in deep stretch while flattening out. MISTER VELVET raced evenly at mid track, put to severe left handed stick in the stretch, lacked rally never threatening. KISS THAT TIGER was briefly in tight leaving the gate, settled in the second flight, varied little despite being hard ridden. FRESH BREWED was off a step slow, raced mid track offering little. FRED'S BEST PAL was quickly outrun, dull effort.
