**Footnotes**

CITY SNEAKERS was never fart off the leader down the backside, bid three wide going into the far turn, edged clear at the quarter pole and was challenged by SOVEREIGN ROAD to his outside, came out to the three path entering the stretch, moved clear once again in mid stretch, was kept to task holding safe late. GOOD FAMILY settled in the second flight, roused mid turn, came four wide at the quarter pole, angled to the five path under a stiff drive a furlong out, closed in on the winner nearing the wire finishing a game second. SOVEREIGN ROAD tracked the pace to the far turn, bid four wide almost drawing even with the winner at the quarter pole, was turned away mid stretch, tired late holding onto the show position. SLIVER unhurried early racing off the rail, found best stride upper stretch, gave belated rally improving placing. TURNPIKE TOMMY stalked down the backside, moved to the rail going into the far turn, chased from mid turn, lacked needed kick tiring late. OMEGA ME AMIGO unhurried traveling towards the rear, did show action after the fact but failed to menace. RIDIN' HARD lunged at the break and trailed for three quarters, mildly improved placing but never factored. FARMINGTON was off slowly, moved out to race mid track going down the backside, remained off the rail throughout, tired in upper stretch. VALID RIDE (ARG) hustled to the front setting the pace to the far turn, dug in when headed, fought to the quarter pole, gave way in upper stretch. GOOD QUESTION tracked to the half racing inside, gave way leaving the quarter pole, stopped upper stretch, was eased and rider dismounted.
