SORDISA quickly showed in front, angled inside setting all the pace, repulsed BIG JAY in mid stretch increasing margin, held safe under steady urging. GONE PROSPECTING lacked early foot racing towards the rear, launched rally coming five wide upper stretch, finished strongly picking up second place in a good effort. BIG JAY pressed the winner from the start, loomed to mid stretch, proved no match and tired late being outfinished for second place. AMBER DUBAI tracked around the turn traveling three to four wide, loomed in mid stretch, leveled off needing more late. THUNDER MINISTER settled mid pack, bid three wide upper stretch running between rivals, would be outfinished late fighting for a minor award. TEXAS HOLLADAY was always outrun never factoring. JERSEY STORM CAT flashed brief foot, chased along the rail to the quarter pole, gave way upper stretch.
