KISSIN IN THE DARK broke sharply hustling to a clear lead widening on the turn, in charge racing along the inside down the lane was kept to task late. BLACKSTOCKINGS slow early angled out six wide in upper stretch coming on late to save place. GENUINE JOY chased a loose leader through the turn making no headway into upper stretch, extending in the four path would weaken late. BERYL'S WAY raced evenly off the pace, angled to mid track in upper stretch held position late. ALEXANDRIA WA saving ground proved no menace. BEER DRINKIN SHARI chased a loose leader through the turn then wore down in the four path the final eighth. RABIOSA played no factor racing seven wide through the lane. AGRACIADO was always outrun. CIXI folded up on the turn. REEL SPINNER giving way on the turn had nothing left when easing in upper stretch, was jogged to the wire, bled.
