Footnotes

WINDHAM HILL slow early found stride leaving the turn, hooked SPRING FARM late edging up at mid track. POLITE LIL SIR slow early was swung out six wide in upper stretch, found stride closing in gamely late. DANNY SEZ raced evenly through the turn advancing to bid from between horses in upper stretch, gave all late to no avail. SPRING FARM broke sharply hustling to a clear lead on the turn, digging in to outside pressure became leg weary when run down late. EL INMIGRANTE raced evenly firing to contention in upper stretch, extended inside of rivals would hang late. THE FINAGLER sent hard pressed then chased SPRING FARM through the turn, wore down the last sixteenth. LIQUOREUX slow early was swung seven wide in upper stretch remaining no menace. GOTTA BIN TO WIN stalked close up looming off SPRING FARM through the turn, became weary in upper stretch giving way in drive. SPECCHIO was jammed by MARKDOWN and forced to steady near the three eighths pole, dropped back there with no recovery. MARKDOWN bore in checking while jamming SPECCHIO near the three eighths pole, gave way sharply on the turn.
