ISABELLA JANE stalked close up pressuring into the far turn, dueled abreast LADY VOLDEMORT wresting a short lead near mid track in upper stretch, extending inside of MAY'S PEGASUS the final eighth would edge clear late. MAY'S PEGASUS stalked the pace laying close through the backside, circled out leaving the far turn bidding boldly on the outside shoulder of ISABELLA JANE in upper stretch, all out the last eighth proved second best. NUIT DE ANGEL away slowly stayed back to the far turn, began to respond from the quarter pole swinging eight wide in upper stretch vying evenly the last eighth. SILVER SCREAM raced evenly off the pace, gained to threaten on the far turn angling out seven wide in upper stretch, extending late would hang. LADY VOLDEMORT hustled out would work the pace clinging to a slim lead through the far turn, ceded inside of rivals in upper stretch wearing down in the three path. SENORARITA slow early gained contention on the far turn then leveled off at mid track in upper stretch. SANTORINA sent up early prompted the pace through the backside then wavered on the far turn wilting along the inside in upper stretch. ALLEVIATE was always outrun.
