COME FLY WITH ME well placed, fired from 1/2, hooked foe top lane, drew off. VISALIA DUST laid close up, edged to bid turn, dueled lane, second best. SKIP BAIL slow early, saved ground, rallied inside 1/4 pole, leveled off. WHISPER AND RUN away alertly, pressed pace, clung to lead, collared lane, wilted. SEA DAISY dropped back, never fired. WHERE'S SALLY hard ridden, no rally. ANSWER DANCER off slowly, labored. SKYBLUE BOMB rushed to top, pressed pace, weary second turn, gave way.
