BECKNERVILLE BOUND broke a bit out putting DATE A SAINT in tight briefly, hustled into the first turn, dueled with DANCE TO THE WIRE to the half, edged away leaving the quarter pole and was kept to task holding safe to the finish. DATE A SAINT was bumped leaving the gate, raced unhurried traveling towards the rear, gained momentum from mid turn, came four wide entering the stretch, gave chase from mid stretch but needed a bit more late finishing a willing second best. DANCE TO THE WIRE dueled with the winner to the far turn, put to a drive giving chase past the quarter pole, angled inside upper stretch, was no late threat but held well saving the show position. DANCE ACTION broke in bumping DATE A SAINT leaving the gate, trailed entering the backside, lacked response till upper stretch, split foes mid stretch racing towards the inside, gave belated surge to finish with interest but never menaced. MR. MARCH raced evenly in the second flight, came five wide under a drive top of the stretch, failed to threaten. RUBADUB CHUB was forwardly placed tracking a contested pace saving ground to the far turn, mounted a brief bid mid turn, failed to sustain move and flattened out upper stretch. MYLESGATOR raced in mid pack to the half, gave way leaving the far turn and finished well beaten.
