Footnotes

NO RAIN NO RAINBOW stalked the pace firing to clear on the far turn, moved off under a drive in upper stretch winning as much the best. OPPOSITE unhurried early gave a mild rally in upper stretch coming on for place along the inside. STOP HUNTING raced evenly coming five wide in upper stretch, outbid the others from mid track. RED BANDIT sent clear set a modest pace through the backside, ceded on the far turn wearing down through the lane. DOLCE LUSSO hesitated at the break, moved evenly off the pace into upper stretch finding no late surge. STORMY PUDDLES stalked through the backside then dropped off on the far turn fading through the stretch. UNCLE TED slow early was never involved. ZACH'S SUNRISE was always outrun. GOOD TROUBLE folded up early.
