Footnotes

IT'S GOTTA BE US vied for the lead in the opening strides then was smartly taken back to stalk, put to a drive angling four wide top of the lane, drew even vying for the lead mid stretch, slowly edged clear under and all out drive in deep stretch. MARLI'S MAN broke well and stalked saving ground to top of the stretch, angled out three wide launching rally, put a head in front mid stretch, fought hard to deep stretch, was outfinished by the winner nearing the wire, settled for second best in a hard try. WEB GEM tracked racing mid track, came four to five wide upper stretch, secured the show position late but never menaced top pair. MYMAMADONTDANCE was hard used making the front, set the pace racing along the inside, battled to the sixteenth pole once headed, gave way late, used up. TETON STAR trailed racing off the rail around the bend, raced six wide under a stiff drive top of the stretch, needed more late never threatening. KING DISCO lacked speed and trailed mid turn, angled out seven wide mid stretch, lacked response never factoring. CAT AND CUSTARD hustled and raced up close briefly, began to drop off leaving the quarter pole, finished spent.
