BILLY'S DILLYBAR slow early advanced four wide turn, dueled abreast down the lane, extended up driving. MAJOR STRIKE chased then pressed to lead, dueled inside of foe down the stretch, ceded grudgingly. JEBBEY JR off slowly, lost ground to upper stretch, bid belatedly seven wide. FLASH FOREVER pressed early, dropped off on the turn, six wide upper stretch, bid evenly. JOE'S LAD chased through the turn, extended along the inside down the lane, weakened. MIKES MONSTER saved ground in pursuit, bid from rail down the lane, weakened. MARKET TUMBLE slow early played no factor. JAKES STORM BUCK was always outrun. DENIZEN chased from mid pack through the turn, gave way in upper stretch. MESSENGER SPRINGS pressed the pace through the turn, wilted upper stretch.
