Footnotes

ABUNDANTLY BLESSED prompted close up in the early going, moved to leader approaching the 1/4 pole, repelled upper stretch, came again under stiff urging, prevailed gamely. MALVERN ROSE made a short early lead, pressed hard leaving the turn, rebuffed rival upper stretch, dug in clear, drifted out late, ceded in last yards. KEEPONDEALING broke well, stalked the pace, loomed to lane, lacked surge at mid track. PERSIAN SILVER went evenly, saved ground through the turn, proved no menace in drive. LAKESIDE CUP sent early, pressed into turn, chased under a hard ride, weakened from 1/8 pole. RIVER FLOWER raced at mid pack, faded off leaders on turn, kept on the inside stretch, failed to menace. OUR CAROL slow early, never involved. QUEENOFMOUNTAIN dropped back, always outrun. ELAINE'S BOOBOO slow early, trailed.
