DE BRANDON BOY broke alertly, held a slight early edge racing at mid track, was hand urged near the quarter pole, responded to widen as the rider was looking back throughout the stretch run for challengers, was in hand coming to the wire. VIVACI sent hard, pressed the winner to the quarter pole, received severe left handed stick during the stretch run, was no match but proved a game second best. NEXT PUNCH sent hard, raced up close briefly, chased top pair from the quarter pole, angled out top of the lane, never menaced, bested rest. SUNSHINE BO lacked speed, raced wide on the bend, beat weary foes, never factored. KILLIAN'S GLORY gave a brief chase, weakened top of the stretch, no factor. OUT OF INK lacked speed, showed little.
