GO GET LOST sent clear moved off on moderate splits through the backside, took a breather on the far turn remaining in control down the stretch. AUTUMN PROMISE away slowly was circled out into upper stretch coming on belatedly at mid track to salvage place. BIG X'S AND O'S raced evenly through the backside chasing from the two path on the far turn, extended down the stretch would hang late. BESTINTHEWORLD stayed back through the far turn, angled inside to upper stretch gave a rail move before leveling off late. CRAFTY TIGRESS tracked evenly through the far turn, made a mild three wide move in upper stretch then faded late. ESME was bumped at the start and on the first turn, would fold up after a half mile easing to the wire. YSTALYFERA stalked the loose pacesetter to the half, empty on the far turn was eased through the stretch. CHILLAXIN' dropping back early was eased through the lane.
