AD LITEM bumped at the break would save ground firing inside the quarter pole circling out four wide to upper stretch surging clear there under a drive. WHITEY'S GOLD slow early angled five wide to upper stretch vying willingly late at mid track. HENRY'S POSSE stalked close up through the turn, extended in the three path down the lane would weaken late. POWER GRACE chased early then dropped off on the turn finishing evenly in the two path. MARK TO MARKET was hustled along weakening on the turn, came four wide in upper stretch then angled six wide late finishing with little left. CALL ME DUTCHESS was never involved racing six wide through the stretch. PHANTOM RISING sent hard set an inside pace through the turn then gave way to pressure along the rail in upper stretch. LOVIN SABRINA struggled throughout.
