SENATOR GOLDSTEIN quickly showed in front, set all the pace traveling three wide, drew off from upper stretch and won in hand as much the best. RUNZEN rushed hard from the gate, brushed lightly with RED CARPET QUEEN going down the backside, chased the winner around the bend, never threatened but held well proving second best. RED CARPET QUEEN hustled early, raced between foes going down the backside, brushed with RUNZEN shortly after the start, chased from mid turn, never menaced and saved show position while tiring late. THE RIDER OF RED CARPET QUEEN CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF RUNZEN CLAIMING INTERFERENCE IN THE RUN DOWN THE BACKSTRETCH, AFTER REVIEW, THIS CLAIM WAS DISMISSED. CONGAREESBUTTERCUP raced evenly running along the rail to the quarter pole, angled out under a drive top of the lane, lacked needed surge. NAUGHTY AND NICE hustled along, raced five wide around the turn, failed to threaten besting rest. LOVE MY BUDDHA was outrun to the quarter pole, found belated stride to improve placing but was no factor. GINNY'S DESIGN lacked speed, roused to no avail, no factor. NEVER DENIED flashed speed, raced up close to mid turn, faded entering the stretch. PASS ME A DRINK lacked speed and raced in the second flight, offered little. ANN SO BE IT was briefly in tight leaving the gate, quickly dropped far off the pace, lagged behind never factoring.
