SUGAR N TABACCO sent hard chased through the turn, drew even in upper stretch giving all to no avail. PRIVATE COSMO tracked evenly through the turn, extended down the lane lacked a late response. GRANDE COEUR slow early played no factor. MOON IS A STAR was never involved. MANHASSET INDIAN hustled wide would tire. RAYWICK was always outrun. AMERICAN MINER offered little.
