FLYINGPALM broke alertly, set all the pace racing off the rail, swung three to four wide turning away FULLO SUCCESS in upper stretch, moved a little towards the inside at the eighth pole, held TENCATI safe nearing the wire winning under steady encouragement. TENCATI settled early, advanced mid turn, angled to the rail mid stretch, finished willingly proving second best. FULLO SUCCESS stalked early on, bid four wide entering the stretch looming off the winner, could not keep pace from mid stretch, tired late saving the show position. ULTRA REGENT showed good speed pressing the winner down the backstretch, began to chase past the quarter pole, was no threat in deep stretch, bested rest. PRAYER ANSWERED was sluggish while trailed to the quarter pole, gave a mild response under urging in the lane improving placing but never threatened. IFPUSHCOMESTOSHOVE showed brief foot, dropped off slightly near the quarter pole, no menace in the lane. MORE HUMOR varied little racing five wide early, lacked response when roused. SINCERE MAN tracked briefly going down the backside, gave way leaving the quarter pole, no factor.
