Footnotes

RIDE IN THE PARK patiently ridden to the far turn, gained momentum from mid turn, came four wide entering the stretch, drew abreast rivals mid stretch, slowly drew clear late under strong handling. ARCH ENEMY ONE lagged to the far turn racing mid track, swung six wide into the stretch, surged strongly nearing the wire gaining second place in a game effort. ROBYNS AFAIRE tracked to mid turn, quickly bid running three wide at the quarter pole, vied for the lead turning for home, was outfinished late dueling for second place. WILD PROOF battled for early control running along the rail, ceded control after a half, came again top of the late cutting the corner, loomed off the leader to mid stretch, flattened out late. THRU THE DESERT tracked racing along the inside, angled out under left handed stick in upper stretch, lacked needed punch. MONTE was forwardly placed going to the half, put to a drive mid turn, loomed off the duelers at the quarter pole, failed to sustain move and tired mid stretch. TEN BELLS prompted the pace traveling two wide to the half, took a slight advantage leaving the far turn, was headed from both sides top of the lane, had nothing left by mid stretch giving way. ICE BERLIN lacked speed racing mid track, gave way at the quarter pole and finished well beaten.
