**Footnotes**

SARAH DOUGLAS rated early traveling wide down the backside, advanced in the five path mid turn, angled six wide under an all out drive mid stretch, surged clear nearing the wire gaining a hard earned victory. PRIZE FEVER tracked the pace around the bend, moved for the lead top of the stretch racing five wide and between foes, vied in deep stretch, was outfinished by the winner holding second place in a good try. EMILY SUN SHINE stalked down the backstretch, bid three to four wide mid turn, edged clear at the quarter pole, collared inside the eighth pole, wore down late to settle for third place. THE NATIVE BLAZE rated and raced in the second flight, swung seven wide top of the lane, loomed at the eighth pole, leveled off needing more late. PATEL MOON unhurried in the early going, came widest traveling in the eight path upper stretch, bid mid stretch, leveled off late. MIDNIGHT ABBEY raced in the second flight at mid track, slightly improved placing in the lane but never factored. PAWN SHOP QUEEN lunged at the break, trailed to the quarter pole, showed belated interest improving position but never factored. A LITTLE GRAND was hard used leaving the gate, dueled to the quarter pole, faded from mid stretch. MISS DOLAN'S ROSE tracked early, raced between foes mid turn giving chase, gave way upper stretch. BLAZINETT flashed brief speed, chased around the turn racing inside, stopped upper stretch.
