DADDY J U stalked early pressing up to challenge on the turn, duelled in the three path down the lane edging up gamely late. HELLIECAT hustled in pursuit rallied to put a head in front on the turn, dueling abreast rival from mid track down the stretch would cede grudgingly. JOHN'S BURGER slow early stayed back on the turn, circled six wide into upper stretch found best stride after the fact. TAXICAB slow early gave a mild rally on the turn then bid evenly from the four path through the stretch. SINGINGWITHANGELS pursued while saving ground, wore down near the rail the final eighth. YUKON PETE chased early then dropped off on the turn. CRAFTY MARK broke sharply to the early lead, hooked on the turn would give way in upper stretch. ALL THE GLORY was always outrun. PATRICK N DYLAN gave way on the turn. OLIVER played no factor.
