Footnotes

TRANSACTION fog, stalked close up, rallied abreast mid stretch, surged clear in the four path. COFFEE GOSSIP fog, pressed along the inside, dug in upper stretch, was overpowered late. WISE MR. BEAN fog, slow early, angled out upper stretch, came on to finish well. WYNN BY GEORGE fog, pressed through the turn then wore out upper stretch. TO THE LEFT fog, pressed early, gave way into upper stretch. GHOSTOFGLODY fog, folded up into stretch. BEAR'S A WINNAH fog, played no factor. ASTUTEST fog, was never involved. RED BIRD SOLDIER fog, gave way upper stretch. HARLAN DAVIDSON fog, well back stretch. DENSE FOG PROHIBITED A HALF CALL FROM BEING MADE.
