Footnotes

STORM DIAMOND broke sharply to the early lead, moved measured into the turn, headed from the outside near the 1/4 pole, cut loose retaking the lead in upper stretch, held firm to wire. MISS T. V. G. off slowly, outrun through the turn, circled out 6 wide in upper stretch, surged on the outside to salvage place. FAST AND FLUID bumped bobbling briefly after the break, advanced on the inside to loom in upper stretch, lacked a closing punch. CHECKER SUE broke alertly to go on the pace, pressed STORM DIAMOND putting a head in front near the 1/4 pole, was overpowered by rival in upper stretch, wore down under a drive. LADY AFLAIR sent hard pressing early, rushed 5 wide into the turn, put to a drive near the 1/4 pole, weakened inside the 1/8 pole. MISS BONN BONN hustled on the inside, pursued full out into the stretch, tired the final 1/16. YOUNITY dropped back early, varied little to mid turn, gave some response gaining into the lane, leveled off there in drive. IMPRESSIVE STAR a step slow, was hustled through the turn, wilted at the head of the lane. MELISSA'S LUV SONG raced evenly under little pressure early, saved ground on the turn, gave way inside the 1/4 pole. EMILY SPINACH dropped far back early, eased through the lane.
