DONERAILE BELLE was patiently ridden, asked far turn, quickly gained along the rail mid turn, vied coming to the quarter pole, drove clear turning for home, held safe under steady handling to the finish. KALWAIN stalked the pace traveling in the three path, vied at the quarter pole in a three way battle, gave hard chase to the winner throughout the stretch run, could not menace late, was easily second best. LEGAL MANDATE lagged far off the pace, angled towards the inside near the quarter pole, hit stride upper stretch, closed well gaining the show position but was no threat to top pair. SHEBA'S DREAM raced evenly in mid pack, mildly gained turning for home, leveled off never menacing. ALL IN KISSIN broke a bit out and was taken up briefly, settled far off the pace, swung six wide under a stiff drive top of the lane, failed to factor. FEARFUL WOMAN raced evenly and off the rail, roused mid turn, failed to respond. GATEWAY LADY set a solid pace running in the three path, headed form both sides mid turn, had nothing left by upper stretch, gave way at the furlong marker. BETMEIFUCAN rushed early, stalked while running four wide down the backside, chased leaving the far turn, gave way on the bend and stopped entering the stretch, weary.
