N. Y. FRIEND hustled to clear set a modest pace while saving ground to upper stretch, widened a bit there then needed all late to hold off a surging CURIE near the wire. CURIE unhurried off the pace found stride in mid stretch running at N. Y. FRIEND from the four path arriving just late. SPRING MANDATE laid close up following N. Y. FRIEND down the backside, hard roused on the far turn pressed the leader from the quarter pole being turned back to upper stretch, extended in drive had little left at the finish. BABY SIS slow early would labor through the far turn, cut the corner to upper stretch coming on late from the rail. MY SWEET MATTY G tracked the pace through the backside edging closer to threaten on the far turn, wavered into upper stretch dropping off there. PREACHER brushed at the break stayed back throughout. JOE'S PENNY was always a step slow. LAST NICKLE raced evenly while saving ground then gave way in upper stretch. CLASSIC SANDI offered little. VALHALLA'S PRIDE dropped far back easing in upper stretch.
