TEQUILA hopped at the break, advanced four deep through the turn, wrested the lead in the three path mid stretch drawing out late. GLEAMING HALO breaking sharply pressured the pace wresting the lead on the turn, engaged by TEQUILA in upper stretch proved no match while holding well inside to salvage place. CHA CHA FOR NOW a step slow early rushed to bid on the turn, lost momentum in upper stretch finishing evenly in the four path. DEBS PRETTYGIRL chased along the inside through the turn, extending from the rail in upper stretch would weaken late. PRIZE FEVER dropped back early, taken seven wide in upper stretch remained no factor. BAGATELLE TERRACE was never involved racing six wide through the lane. MARGARET PRIDE was always outrun. GHOST TOWN KAT bobbling at the break would fold up on the turn. LA FRANCISCA showed early speed then weakened on the turn, was put away in mid stretch.
