KNOWNFORSTONE patiently handled down the backside, came four wide mounting rally entering the stretch, closed strongly in the final sixteenth to win going away. CROFTER hustled to the front, set a pressured pace racing along the inside, held a slight lead deep stretch but was no match for KNOWNFORSTONE coming to the wire but did hold well saving second place. BID'S REWARD matched strides with the runner up around the turn and to deep stretch, was outfinished late and settled for third place in a very hard try. PETER THE GROSS stalked along the rail to the quarter pole, began to tire mid stretch despite being hard ridden, bested rest. SUPREMACY settled in the second flight and saved ground to top of the stretch, angled out to the three path under a drive, failed to menace. STARLITS LAD rated early racing in the second flight, made a mild bid mid turn to race in mid pack, soon flattened out mid stretch, no late factor. ROMA'S WORLD was always outrun racing wide throughout, never factored. MEGA WONDER hustled early and chased to mid turn, gave way entering the stretch, finished well beaten.
