Footnotes

SKOAL RING rushed from the gate, dueled inside of TWICE SPECIAL to top of the stretch, drew off under a strong hand ride, won being ridden out. COUNT ON DOC stalked a contested pace, angled entering the stretch, loomed off the winner in upper stretch, was turned away inside the furlong marker, held place position in game effort. MALABAR BAY reserved early, raced towards the inside around the turn, gained momentum entering the stretch, angled out mid stretch, closed in willing manner. JUST MIKE bumped with STANDER shortly after the start, trailed to the quarter pole, came six wide entering the stretch, found best stride too late, finished with interest but was no threat. TWICE SPECIAL was sent hard, dueled with SKOAL RING to top of the lane, began to tire inside the eighth pole, no late factor. BLUES CROSSING traveled evenly running five wide around the turn, hard ridden into the stretch, failed to respond, no threat. STANDAR bumped at the start, rushed up stalking a contested pace racing along the inside, gave way in upper stretch.
