Footnotes

AFTON'S COURAGE tracked down the backside racing between foes, bid three wide taking aim on the winner top of the lane, angled to the rail mid stretch, drew off late finishing with good energy widening to the wire. RUBY LITE broke sharply and quickly opened up, raced well clear around the turn, traveled in the two to three path form upper stretch, proved no match in the final furlong and finished second best. GIVEN THE GLORY stumbled at the start and broke out brushing MING WIN, rushed up along the rail to chase the leader, hard ridden leaving the quarter pole, lacked needed response while holding the show position. JOE'S RISING STAR was soon outrun, trailed to the quarter pole, showed belated interest improving placing but never factored. MING WIN was brushed by GIVEN THE GLORY at the start, raced in tandem down the backside running between foes, dropped off and angled to the rail mid turn, chased under urging leaving the quarter pole, failed to respond and tired in the lane. HIDDEN ATTACK gave chase racing three to four wide down the backside, dropped off entering the stretch, spent. ROSIE'S PRAYER tracked the leader down the backside racing wide abreast rivals, was hung out wide around the bend giving chase, gave way entering the stretch.
