CALL THE GUY broke alertly setting the pace in the three path through the turn, floated to the five path in upper stretch held inside rivals at bay. CHON stalked the pace looming close up through the turn, extending in the two path down the stretch proved no match for the winner. EURO CASH hustled on the inside chased through the turn, all out along the rail down the stretch would hang late. BEA'S TREASURE chased the pace through the turn then weakened in the four path upper stretch. BANK OF DAD slow early was swung out six wide in upper stretch proving no menace. DOWN THE ROAD pursued early in the three path, wavered near the quarter pole fading from contention in upper stretch. CHAPEL RUN played no factor racing eight wide through the stretch. SHARP PICK faded on the turn, raced nine wide down the stretch. FAST PROMISES angled inside early remained sluggish swinging out seven wide in upper stretch.
