LUCKY LILY was never far back, asked into the lane, was under strong left handed stick, wore down a faltering leader in deep stretch, won going away . MIDNIGHTVICTORY sprinted to a large lead, was never challenged, well clear into the lane, faltered near the 1/16 pole, was all out to save the place position . COLD ONE slow early, put to the whip on the backside, split foes mid turn, angled into the stretch, was finishing very strong but too late . GARDENESS'S GEM sent hard, moved off the rail on the turn, chased into the lane, was hard ridden in the drive, had no response, finished evenly. MIGHTY DEELITE raced along the rail, made a brief bid mid turn, soon leveled off, lacked finishing bid. LOSTMYMAID raced evenly throughout, was roused mid turn, gave no response, finished evenly . GOLDEN DRAGON (FR) slow early, angled to the rail early backside, made a minor gain in the stretch run while being no threat. WIN ZONE came away in good order, tracked while racing off the rail, angled 6 wide entering the stretch, was under a drive but gave no response and tired late. PATTONS SUCCESS went evenly early, raced wide throughout, was 5 wide near the 3/8 pole, was tiring throughout the stretch run . ECHO LOCATION raced between on the turn, asked for more, came up empty and was weary near the wire.
