Footnotes

ALEDO SPLASH stalked early splitting foes near the quarter pole collaring LUCKY EXPRESS into upper stretch, moved abreast rival gradually edging clear in drive. LUCKY EXPRESS sent inside pressed rivals through the turn extending from the rail in upper stretch, locked up with ALEDO SPLASH would cede grudgingly. RIGHT FLANKER slow early was angled inside rallying along the rail through the lane. SCOTTIE off slowly trailed the field through the turn, found belated stride to improve late. HAIL TO THE CAT slow early was taken wide in upper stretch remaining no menace. JILLUKE outrun early gave a mild move on the turn then leveled near mid track in drive. XTRA JACK was never involved finishing wide. MAKERS AT MIDNIGHT pressed the pace dueling between horses from the quarter pole, gave way empty to upper stretch. OROZCO gave hard pursuit through the turn then wilted in upper stretch.
