Footnotes

LIVELY EXIT was patiently ridden racing four wide down the backside, angled towards the inside near the quarter pole, cut the corner entering the stretch, loomed off the runner up in mid stretch while in close quarters, angled out late for room, surged under a drive to arrive in time. ALYTORO hustled leaving the gate, angled towards the inside setting a pressured pace, dug in receiving strong lefty handed stick, could not hold off LIVELY EXIT in last jumps, missed in a very determined effort. FALCON LAKE unhurried from the gate, raced in the second flight, angled out mid turn, came six wide top of the lane, rallied in tandem coming to the wire, finished willingly. PRECAUTIONARY well placed, raced up close to the far turn, split foes and vied at the quarter pole, failed to sustain bid and was out finished in deep stretch. MILWAUKEE HIGH settled in the second flight, advanced mid turn, came five wide to a menacing position in upper stretch, needed more late. GIANT SURGE was forwardly placed traveling four wide to the far turn, vied at the quarter pole, began to fade mid stretch, used up. CHANCE'S CODE pressed the pace to the half, was all done leaving the quarter pole giving way, finished weary. ALL PLAY raced in mid pack to the far turn, gave way mid turn, well beaten. ONE LAST GRAF was always outrun, never involved. FREE WHISKEY was never involved, dull effort.
