Footnotes

THIS IS MY GAME rushed to the front, set all the pace traveling off the rail, turned away THE FLY'N'JACAMACOO in upper stretch, won comfortably under steady encouragement. TAXICAB settled in mid pack, angled towards the inside mid stretch, rallied willingly securing second place late. THE FLY'N'JACAMACOO tracked to mid turn, rallied four wide near the quarter pole to loom off the winner, was turned away mid stretch then was outfinished late missing second place. RIGHT ON lacked speed racing towards the rear, rallied six wide top of the lane, leveled off needing more late. RUNNING BOWLINE raced along the rail throughout, failed to menace despite being hard ridden. THREEWISEMEN was outrun racing wide down the backstretch, showed some belated interest to improve placing but never factored. EFFERVESCENT CHARM showed good early speed pressing the winner briefly, stalked around the turn, started to fade in upper stretch. SEGUE flashed speed giving chase running along the rail, gave way entering the stretch. EMMETT'S LAW lacked speed and made a steady retreat from the quarter pole.
