FINISHING TOUCH broke out bumping HUGE HPOE leaving the gate, settled in the second flight, sat patient to mid turn, rallied coming five wide entering the stretch, came in a bit tightening up BOCCE in upper stretch, drew off from mid under a drive to the wire. MAINY raced three wide into the first turn, moved out to the four path midway down the backside, vied in a four way battle turning for home, came out slightly in upper stretch to squeeze BOCCE briefly, duelled with the winner to mid stretch, proved no match in the final furlong while holding second place in a game effort. BOCCE was brushed taking up briefly shortly after the start, settled in the second flight, gained from mid turn, vied racing between foes in upper stretch, was squeezed briefly losing position, continued on late in a willing manner saving third place. THE TRAINER OF BOCCE CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF FINISHING TOUCH FOR INTERFERENCE IN UPPER STRETCH, AFTER REVIEW, THIS CLAIM WAS DISMISSED AND RESULTS STOOD AS IS. BOLD MODEL was taken in hand leaving the gate, angled to the rail traveling towards the rear, hit stride leaving the quarter pole, loomed off duelers mid stretch, leveled off a bit needing more late. HUGE HOPE was bumped by FINISHING TOUCH leaving the gate then moved out to brush BOCCE, hustled into the first turn to take control, set the pace running towards the inside, headed at the quarter pole, fought to mid stretch then yielded losing ground to the wire. BIRD OF HONOR lacked speed trailed for six furlongs, swung out seven wide upper stretch, beat a couple of weary foes never factoring. LA FLAMME pressed the early pace, raced between rivals down the backside, began to fade leaving the quarter pole. MERIDA CITY raced four wide into the first turn, stalked to the half, was all done entering the stretch giving way in the lane.
