FUNNYS APPROVAL well placed running along the inside to the quarter pole, angled to the three path entering the stretch, drove by WESTSIDE SINGER in upper stretch, widened easily being ridden out. WESTSIDE SINGER rushed into the far turn, moved clear and angled towards the inside, was no match for the winner from mid stretch, dug in saving place under strong encouragement. ATSILA settled early, made a four wide run mid turn, loomed off the leader at the quarter pole, leveled off mid stretch besting rest. MY SAVANNAH showed good early speed, stalked around the turn racing three wide, began to weaken mid stretch, no late threat. ENGLATERRA lacked sped racing towards the inside, mildly bid in the lane but failed to factor. HAPPY NINER trailed to the quarter pole, swung widest racing in the seven path upper stretch, passed a couple of weary foes but never menaced. TEXAS FLEETING raced evenly in mid pack to the three eighths pole, faded from upper stretch. MISS HORSE DOCTOR flashed brief speed, steadily gave way from the quarter pole finishing spent.
