RHETORIC slow early saved ground into the turn, circled out near the quarter pole advancing quickly six wide into upper stretch, led abreast rivals angling in while drawing out late. R U LUCKY broke alertly pressuring the pace dueling inside of S S PATRIOT to upper stretch, extending in the two path was overpowered by a late running RHETORIC hanging on for place. S S PATRIOT stalked early angling out near the five eighths pole, pressed up challenging on the turn dueling abreast R U LUCKY to upper stretch, joined on the outside by RHETORIC would prove no match for the latter while holding well in the four path. SWARR slow early had a mild gain on the turn threatening from the three path in upper stretch, extending late would level off. TEN GALLON a step slow early gained from the quarter pole moving to contention at mid track in upper stretch, hard roused late would wear down. RED ON THE HEAD dropped back early. SIPPIN THE DEW played no factor. MAJUR POLLARD pressured the pace through the turn then folded abruptly in the three path upper stretch. SUDDSY SUNDAY done early was eased to wire.
