Footnotes

SISTER IN THE CITY stalked the pace firing to collar WALTZING TIME in upper stretch, put away rival inside the eighth pole drawing out in the four path. SUNNYWAY a step slow through the turn saved ground to upper stretch rallying late in the two path to salvage place. WALTZING TIME breaking sharply would widen on pace through the turn, collared in the three path upper stretch would wear down. DESIRABLE DESIREE slow early came seven wide in upper stretch improving position late. CLIQUE dropped back early trailing through the turn, came six wide in upper stretch angling in a bit while no menace. SEVEN TIGERS retreated on the turn. LEADER OF THE LITE bobbled causing the rider to lose his irons at the break, quickly regained hurrying from off the pace failing to reach contention. COUNTRY SINGER away well gave hard pursuit through the turn then gave way abruptly in upper stretch.
