TOUCH OF SILVER rushed along the rail soon after the start to set the pace, drew off entering the stretch, won easily being ridden out. INTERNATIONAL GUY showed good early speed, stalked racing along the rail throughout, could not keep pace with the winner from the eighth pole, but fought hard winning the battle for second place. FRESH CUT broke alertly, stalked the winner traveling in the three path from the start, was no menace in deep stretch and was edged out of second place late. ROYAL CHAPEL was a step slow leaving the gate, hustled up to track the leader going into the far turn, put to strong left handed stick in the lane, lacked needed surge besting rest. BREAKING FREE raced evenly traveling mid track, failed to respond when roused, no threat. ENJOYABLE JOURNEY lacked speed, never involved. SMOKIN WINNIE JOE was always outrun, dull try. SUPER SWOOPER hustled leaving the gate, gave a brief chase, began to drift very wide mid turn, was pulled up near the quarter pole.
